

## **Wine Spectator - Current Buying Guide: May 31, 2018 - Joseph Drouhin reds 2015**

### **2015 Joseph Drouhin Chambolle-Musigny – 93 Points**

This is polished and expressive, featuring blackberry, blueberry, graphite and spice flavors. Rich, yet fluid and fresh, with a firm backbone of tannins for support. Shows fine lift and length on the spice- and mineral-tinged aftertaste. Best from 2023 through 2042.

### **2015 Joseph Drouhin Charmes-Chambertin – 96 Points**

Taut and polished, with black cherry, blackberry, licorice and spice flavors locked in the embrace of voluminous tannins. Ample sweet fruit comes to the fore on the lingering finish, where the spice accents continue. Best from 2023 through 2045.

### **2015 Joseph Drouhin Côte de Beaune – 90 Points**

A fluid, vibrant red, this offers cherry, currant and earth flavors. With a supple texture and fine balance, this adds up to an enticing and elegant style. Drink now through 2022.

### **2015 Joseph Drouhin Gevrey-Chambertin – 92 Points**

Captivating aromas and flavors of pure cherry, mineral, tobacco and spice mark this supple red. Beautifully balanced, this remains long on the finish, driven by succulent acidity. Best from 2020 through 2033.

### **2015 Joseph Drouhin Nuits-St.-Georges 1er Cru Procès – 94 Points**

This is rich, featuring a silky sheen that wraps around macerated cherry, currant and toasty oak flavors. Solidly structured, with finely woven tannins picking up the texture on the finish. Best from 2023 through 2038.

### **2015 Joseph Drouhin Vosne-Romanée – 93 Points**

A solid core of cherry, currant and blueberry fruit is shaded by earth, mineral and spice notes in this vibrant red. Balanced and resonant, with hints of cinnamon and nutmeg on the extended finish. Best from 2021 through 2036.
