

JOSEPH DROUHIN Meursault 2014 - Score: 89

Tasting Note: A broad, rich white, with peach, lemon and baking spice flavors buoyed by crisp acidity. Feels open and approachable, yet should improve over the short term. Drink now through 2020.—BS

JOSEPH DROUHIN Puligny-Montrachet 1er Cru Folatières 2014 – Score: 93

Tasting Note: Chalky, mineral aromas and an element of austerity mark this elegant, compact white. Peach, lemon and baking spice flavors fade gracefully as this winds down on the long finish. Best from 2019 through 2030. —BS

JOSEPH DROUHIN Chassagne-Montrachet 1er Cru Morgeot Marquis de Laguiche 2014 - Score: 93

Tasting Note: A taut, smoky style, with citrus, butterscotch and mineral flavors etched onto the refined structure. Remains juicy and persistent, even as the fruit gives way to the oak before returning again on the long aftertaste. Intense. Best from 2018 through 2028.—BS

JOSEPH DROUHIN Côte de Beaune-Villages 2014 Score: 87

Tasting Note: This has some tension, displaying cherry, strawberry and spice flavors on a trim frame. Balanced and moderately long, opening after a few hours of aeration. Drink now through 2019.—BS

JOSEPH DROUHIN Gevrey-Chambertin 2014 - Score: 92

Tasting Note: Rich and inviting, featuring cherry, strawberry and spice flavors that remain persistent through the finish. Balanced, with civilized tannins and excellent length. Best from 2019 through 2032.—BS

JOSEPH DROUHIN Vosne-Romanée 2014 – Score: 91

Tasting Note: An expressive red, featuring cherry and spice flavors, with flourishes of smoke and autumn vegetation. Supple and harmonious, with a lingering aftertaste of fruit, spice and savory elements. Best from 2020 through 2033. —BS

JOSEPH DROUHIN Nuits-Saint-Georges 1er Cru Procès 2014 - Score: 90

Tasting Note: Sweet, spicy oak frames cherry and strawberry notes in this elegant, supple red. Finishes fresh and vibrant, with echoes of fruit and spice. Best from 2018 through 2027. 30 cases imported. —BS

JOSEPH DROUHIN Charmes-Chambertin Grand Cru 2014 – Score: 92

Tasting Note: Wood smoke and toasty spice notes envelop the black cherry and earth flavors in this firm yet fluid red. Though tannic, this is fresh and packed with flavor that resonates on the long finish. Best from 2020 through 2033.—BS
